AGING AND WEATHERING WASHES:

Water-based wash:

8 ounces rubbing alcohol
8 ounces water
1 tablespoon India ink

Solvent-based wash:

8 ounces mineral spirits paint thinner
1/2 teaspoon lamp black
1/2 teaspoon burnt sienna
