



## Quick Reference Card

### For TS-4 Easy Weathering Techniques Video or DVD

1. Always weather your models under the same lighting as they will be viewed.
2. To lighten light colored paints add 5% white.
3. To lighten dark colored paints add up to 25% white.
4. Black Wash: 1 teaspoon India ink in 16 ounces (pint) of 70% rubbing alcohol
5. Oil Stain: 1/2 inch of tube-type Burnt Sienna (or another color) mixed into 3 ounces (or more) of mineral spirits.
6. Dry Brushing brush: Grumbacher 626-B, sizes 4 through 8.
7. Pastel chalks: Available from art supply stores and Micro Mark.
8. Wet Water: Several drops detergent in 16 ounces of tap water.

- Water soluble hobby paints
- India ink
- 70% Rubbing alcohol
- Craft store acrylic colors
- Funnel
- Tube oil colors
- Measuring spoons
- Pastel chalk
- Mineral spirit paint thinner
- Assorted brushes
- Paache Model H airbrush
- Tester's Dull Cote
- Wet water
- Tester's Aztec airbrush with a #3 tip
- Coarse flat file
